Here is a glance at what is going on.

- 1. Book It for November is due on Wednesday, 11/30. It is part of their homework and hope it will be turned in on time.**
- 2. For religion during Advent I cover the Jesse tree. Each day I will read a story from the Bible and have an ornament that goes with it. Each day the children will bring home an ornament with a symbol on it. Each symbol represents the story in the bible leading up to the birth of Jesus. Please put a hanger on the ornament, ask the child what the story is about and hang it on your Christmas tree at home.**
- 3. Classroom clothing- please send warm clothing for your child to wear at school. They are telling me they are cold. Please send a sweatshirt or sweater with their name in it so they can wear it at school. Also, when they have snow clothes please make sure you dry them each night- it is no fun to put on wet clothes the next day.**
- 4. Homework- During this busy season I will try to keep the homework to a minimum. I do ask that you keep working on the alphabet literacy chart. Please write the date on the back each time you go over it. We will put a sticker on each date that is written on the back. Remember I ask that the children know all their letters and sounds by Christmas break.**
- 5. Please send in the Christmas Family information in as soon as possible if you are able to help.**
- 6. Please remember that during this busy time the children need extra sleep. It is the best way to keep them on their best behavior and keep them healthy.**
