### Power Point Guidelines

Before going to the computer:

- 1) Research the as much of the following information as possible about the explorer you have chosen.
  - a) Year of birth and death including age at death
  - b) City and country of birth and death
  - c) Map of explorations – well labeled
  - d) Facts about family
  - e) Personal information
  - f) Picture of the explorer
  - g) Any major accomplishments or events of the explorer's life
- 2) Draw a plan for each slide including all text that will be on the slide and how it will be laid out and 2 or 3 sentences that you will read as you present each slide.
- 3) Save any research facts that you will use in a folder in your personal folder on your U-drive

When all the above is completed, you may open Power Point and begin creating your power point.

- 1) Type text on every slide.
- 2) Add pictures or graphics
- 3) Work with the other tools on power point to make the presentation educational and informative.
- 4) Save your power point in your folder.
