

## **PLAYGROUND RULES**

**As of 10/14/10**

### **RESPECT RULES:**

1. Be respectful to other students and supervisor'.
2. Behaviors and actions should not cause a problem for another. (e.g. spitting, bullying, throwing rocks, etc)
3. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
4. Do not kick, bounce, or throw balls near windows, fence, onto the roof, or at others.
5. Respect the space of others' activities.
6. Use good sportsmanship.

### **GENERAL RULES:**

1. When bell rings, hold playground equipment and line up immediately.
2. No eating outside during recesses.
3. Playground supervisor approval needed to play with students more than one grade up or down.
4. Ball diamonds, dumpster areas, north of upper unit, and parking areas are out of bounds.
5. Students should stay at least 10 feet away from fences.
6. Only approved equipment can be used on the playground. (Approval by Ms. Nauditt)

### **SNOW RULES:**

1. No throwing or kicking snow.
2. No sleds.
3. Waterproof boots (Pk-8) and snow pants (Pk-4) are required to leave the blacktop.
4. No sliding on ice.
5. No playing on ice or on mounded snow.

### **EQUIPMENT RULES:**

1. Use playground equipment safely and appropriately.
2. Swing only in a forward and backward motion with your pockets on the seat.
3. Do not jump from any equipment.
4. Certain equipment (e.g. lacrosse sticks) will be permitted in designated area only.

**REPEATED OR SERIOUS OFFENSES WILL RESULT IN CONSEQUENCES. All consequences are subject to situational context. Frequency, severity of action, and age of student will impact consequences.**
